(Hons)** Degree programme will be held in the **Afternoon between 2.00 p.m. and 4.30 p.m.** at the Multipurpose Hall as per the above mentioned schedule. However, the course of **ENVIRONMENTAL LAW** for **Fourth Year B.A. LL.B. (Hons) and B.Com. LL.B. (Hons)** Degree programme will be held in the **forenoon between 10.00 a.m. and 12.30 p.m.**
3. All the End-Semester (Even-Semester) Examinations for **LL.M. programme** will be held in the **Forenoon between 10.00 a.m. and 12.30 p.m.** at the Multipurpose Hall as per the above mentioned schedule.

7. Any student who writes his/her Register Number on any part of the answer book/sheets other than in the space provided or makes any special mark or marking which may disclose in any way the identity of the student, will be liable for disciplinary action.
