

## **The Guidelines and Modalities for Award of Gold Medal at the TNNLU Convocation as approved by the Academic Council in its Meeting held on 30.07.2021:**

The following guidelines shall apply to the award of University Gold medals/awards/trophies/prizes, only to those students who fulfill the following conditions:

- 1) A student must have appeared and passed all the courses in his/her first attempt in the End Semester Examinations conducted for 50/40 marks (as applicable) of the Degree programmes, as approved by the Academic Council.
- 2) Any student who is absent for the End Semester Examinations for any reason including participation in Moot courts, parliamentary debates, client counseling or any academic/co-curricular/extracurricular activities/severe illness and students who have appeared and cleared his/her courses in repeat examinations conducted for 70 marks shall not be considered as eligible candidates for awarding of University Gold medals/awards/trophies/prizes.
- 3) For the purpose of awarding of University Gold medals/awards/trophies/prizes, the actual marks scored by the students in all the Semesters of the respective Programmes, including the End Semester Examinations for 50/40 marks alone will be considered.

**3A)** Gold medals may be awarded on the basis of marks only for the batches of 2021 and 2022 as all the results upto these batches have been declared only in marks. (Though the consolidated marks statement is issued with marks and grades for the batches from 2018 onwards, providing grades in the marks cards was only on the request of the students applying for further studies or for internships.) Thus the gold medals will be awarded on the basis of marks alone upto the Batches of 2021 and 2022.

**3B)** From the 2023 batch onwards, the award of gold medals shall be only on the basis of the grades and CGPA secured, since the results have been declared only in grades from 2023 Batch onwards.

- 4) From the batch of 2023 onwards award of Gold Medals will be only on the basis of CGPA and on the basis of highest marks scored, in case of tie between two or more students with the same CGPA.
- 5) From the batch of 2023 onwards award of subject wise Awards and Medals will be on the basis of highest grade obtained in the concerned subject and when there is a tie the awards will be given to the student/s who has scored higher marks.
