

Instruction to Resident students of TNNLU hostels (For the A.Y. 2022-23)

1. Entry to TNNLU campus is permitted upon submission of any original proof of Identity issued by the state/central Governments.
2. TNNLU has separate hostels for men and women.
3. The TNNLU hostels provide following items to the resident students
 - a. Single cot
 - b. Writing table
 - c. Chair
 - d. Almirah
 - e. Required Plates, tumblers and other mess utensils are available for student's use in TNNLU Mess Hall.
 - f. Room Locks and Keys
4. For the first-year students, the rooms are allotted on sharing basis i.e., 3 students per room.
5. Room allocation is based on first cum first serve basis.
6. Students are hereby informed to bring the following items when they report to the respective hostels:
 - a. Bed spreads
 - b. Blankets
 - c. Pillow and Pillow covers
 - d. Bucket and mug
 - e. Mask and sanitizer
 - f. Medications, if any
 - g. Laptop/Tablet/smartphones and other gadgets
 - h. Broomsticks, Dustbin and Laundry Bags
7. Students are not permitted to bring electric kettle, Induction stove and any other cooking utensils.
8. Campus Doctor is available during scheduled timings every day.
9. Resident Nurse is also available.
10. Washing machines are available in respective hostels.
11. Cloth ironing services on paid basis is available in the neighborhood.
12. Other needed essentials.

Note: There are no stores available within campus to buy essentials and other things, therefore the students are advised to procure items from the city and nearby villages before reaching hostels or from their respective hometowns as case may be.
